#### Admissions 2014-15

# Pre- and after-school clubs

At this time of year we send out details about options for our pre— and after-school clubs and activities. Clubs include: Badminton, Chess, Judo, Chelsea FC football, Cheerleading, Choir, Netball, Drama, Mathematics and Tag Rugby. There are many opportunities for pupils to explore their interests further - we hope that as many as possible take part. During lunchtimes we are trialling the use of SCL activity clubs to support some of our children with playground games. These games are free, open to all and are great for children who want to join in with organised games during lunchtimes.

#### **School Uniform**

It has been good to see that the children have come back to school looking very smart and ready for their learning. Please remember that all uniform **must** be in-line with our school policy. For PE, this includes: pale blue t-shirt and white sports shorts, plimsolls for indoor activities, trainers for outdoor activities; and a plain navy-blue tracksuit for outdoor activities.

Please note that **plain**, single stud earrings are permitted, but with the expectation that they are removed for PE and Games lessons for health and safety reasons. No nail varnish, false nails or make-up may be used at school. Finger nails to be short, neat and clean.

In addition to correct uniform, we expect a smart appearance from all our pupils, **including appropriate hairstyles** and suitable outer garments. Braided hair with beads or coloured decorations, extreme hairstyles, spiked, coloured hair or designs shaved into the hair are not acceptable. If pupils are not wearing the correct uniform, parents will be contacted.

All children with longer hair, boys or girls, are expected to have it tied back. This is for safety reasons as well as to guard against any potential spread of headlice/nits.

The school must reserve the right to decide what is or is not allowed, both in uniform and general appearance, in cases not catered for by specific rules.

## **School Office**

The school office is open from **8.30-9.00am** and **3.00-3.30pm**. All parents must sign in if they have an appointment to speak with a member of staff. For 'quick notes' or messages to junior teachers parents must visit the school office and we will ensure that your message is passed on.

At the back of the school we have storage available for bicycles and scooters if children wish to cycle or scoot to school. 'Cycle to School Passports' are available from the school office by request and if these are taken home, completed and returned, we then allow pupils to leave their bikes and scooters here.
