For:

As a pupil, I will:

- Respect other people’s culture, race, feelings and beliefs.

- Deliver messages and letters between school and home.
- Not use social media to comment on individuals or the school.

- Let the school know as soon as possible of any concerns or worries that may be affecting my child’s learning, behaviour or ability to work so that they can be resolved.
- Attend meetings with my child’s teacher and other staff, aiming to be positive and productive, working towards moving my child on in their learning.
- Provide support with homework when necessary and check that it is done.
- Get to know about my child’s life at Newlands Primary School.
- Support the school behaviour management policy.
- Not take family holidays during term time.
