Daily Reading

Please read every day with your child, taking the time to talk about the story, discuss the pictures and ask questions. Read the story a few times before changing the book to help embed long term word recognition and comprehension skills. Where possible please also read to your child.

Please comment in your child's reading record at least three times a week.

Phonics / Spelling

Please help your child to practise the spellings at least 3 times a week.

Children need to be able to spell the words correctly in the context of a dictated sentence.
