Parent Governor Vacancy

We still have two vacancies for parent governors which we need to fill urgently. If you are interested in the role of parent governor, we would encourage you to contact the school office to make an appointment with Mr Neighbour to find out more.

Newlands Primary School has always aimed for a partnership with parents which undoubtedly brings great benefits to the children. One of the most significant ways you can help in promoting this aim is to volunteer or be a parent governor.

The governing body's main tasks are:

- to ensure that the school has a clear vision, ethos and strategic direction;
- to hold the headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils;
- to oversee the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.

Parent governors are welcomed as valued members of the team and play a vital role in ensuring the governing body is aware of the views of parents and the local community. We feel sure that there are parents prepared to take on this important role and give their time and commitment to help us to continue to improve the school's performance.

You would be expected to play an active role within the school, taking part in regular meetings and taking on special governor roles. The Full Governing Body meet in the evening and the two separate committees meet late afternoon every half term.

In looking to fill this vacancy the governors of the school have identified the following skills, experience and attributes that they feel would help strengthen the governing body:

- Passion to ensure the best education for every child at Newlands Primary School, and an ability to effectively contribute to the strategic discussions
- Connections to local businesses and the community
- Understanding of school budgets and financial performance in increasingly challenging circumstances

Training and support will be available to help you develop into the role. This will include in-house mentoring and support as well as access to external governor training.
